

Come join us for the OTCI tournament at beautiful Lake Sam Rayburn in October. Entry fee is \$275.00 per team. The venue for this event is the Pavilion in Cassels Boykin Park. Registration and check-in will be at the pavilion from 3:00 – 8:00 PM. Meal sponsors will be providing food during the registration period.

There will be one payout for the tournament on day two. This two-day event will not have a limited number of teams. We specifically targeted the fall season to take advantage of cooler weather, schooling bass and provide a venue for oilfield employees that enjoy camaraderie and fishing. For those of you who participated in the past, thank you and we look forward to seeing you again this year. If you didn't have the opportunity to join us last year, sorry you missed it, but don't miss out again this year. Unlike most Oilfield Tournaments, the Trashmaster Classic requires only one team member to be employed in, or retired from the Oil and Gas industry, to qualify the team. Bring a neighbor, friend, or family member from outside the oilfield, just remember, at least one team member must be an oilfield employee.

Tournament hours both days will be from 7:00 am (first cast) – 3:00 p.m. (last cast), for all teams. All participants must be in the weigh in line no later than 4pm each day at Cassels Boykin Pavilion. A post weigh-in meal and awards presentation will be held Friday and Saturday at Cassels Boykin Pavilion.

Should you choose to mail in your registration, please fill out team information below and submit your check, along with this registration form, to secure your spot. Mail-in entries must be received by October 10th. Entry Fee \$275 per team. Payouts to top 20% of the number of paid teams and 2 places for big bass overall for the tournament.

OTCI Rules and Regulations

All anglers are expected to be in compliance with TPWD laws/rules/regulations in respect to boat safety and fish size/bag limit regulations.

- Qualified teams will consist of two registered anglers with at least one angler being employed in or retired from the Oil and Gas industry to be verified by Tournament Directors.
- Lake Sam Rayburn guides or touring professionals are not allowed to participate in the tournament.
- This will be a five (5) fish tournament with only 5 fish per team allowed at weigh in. Culling is allowed but the 6th fish must immediately be returned to the water after weight has been determined.
- Each boat must have an aeriated live well system on board. Presenting a dead fish at weigh-in will result in a .25 lb penalty. This penalty will be deducted from the total Team weight.
- Fishing regulations for Sam Rayburn are as follows:
 For Largemouth, Spotted and Smallmouth Bass Minimum Length is 14 inches.
 Tournament limit is 5 fish in any combination of the above listed species.
- Bass will be checked on a "bump board" at weigh in to ensure minimum length requirement. Any fish not making minimum length will be removed from the Teams bag before putting them on the scales. If TPWD officials are at the weigh in you will be subject to fines and restitution for violations based on their findings.
- > Live bait is not allowed. Artificial lures only.
- Trolling with the "big" motor is not allowed.
- > Only one rod at a time may be used by any contestant in the Tournament.
- No fishing is allowed closer than 100 feet to another tournament angler displaying the OTCI provided flagging tape displayed on his/her trolling motor.



Any team that is not in the weigh-in line a 4:00 PM will have their weight disqualified for that day.
